

TRAVEL DIRECTIONS

See Sydney Street directories. Suburb Waterfall (Sydney's most southern suburb) and/or Map Appin 1:2500 Grid reference 144 201 Third addition

Most of you should be traveling from the north i.e. Sydney and may find it difficult to find Camp Coutts, if you have not been there before. The following is the ONLY route to take to get there – any short cut is dangerous and illegal.

By Road from the north--- Sydney

Travel along the Princes Highway to Waterfall. Pass under the overhead bridge and a further 500 meters along the highway take the right hand lane to veer off to Woronora Dam, the Princes Highway and Sydney. Around this right hand bend you cross over a bridge, (underneath is the Motorway going north). Immediately over this bridge a single lane veers right to Sydney into a right hand bend and joins the Old Princess Highway heading north. This section of highway is straight and you have to move over into the breakdown lane. The highway bends to the left and just around the bend on the left is the entry road to Camp Coutts.

By road from the South—Wollongong or the Picton Rd turnoff (if coming from Canberra)

You must be on the Princess Highway as the highway meets the motorway just past the entry road to Camp Coutts. About half a kilometer before the Camp entrance the southern exit from the Motorway joins the Princess Highway. Continue along for approximately 300m then move over into the breakdown lane. The entry into the camp is on the left just past the bend.

If you get on the motorway by mistake go to Waterfall Township by taking left hand exit before or after the overhead bridge. Make your way over the bridge and turn right, down onto the motorway and follow directions given for traveling from the north.

This section of highway is straight and you have to move over to the left into the breakdown lane. Be careful of speeding vehicles coming up behind you. The highway bends to the left and just around the bend on the left is the entry road to Camp Coutts.

The Camp Road is one kilometer from the highway to the camp gate carpark. The road is mostly very steep and for safety reasons it is advised to use first gear right to the bottom of the sharp left hand bend. On the way out it is again advisable to engage in first gear at the same bend for a safer exit.

Parking: Your vehicle must be parked in the car park adjacent to the main gate. However, you may wish to unload first and then return to the park. See the Ranger if you wish to proceed through the Camp.

By train:

From the station at Waterfall, cross the overhead bridge and walk down the footpath on the left at the end of the bridge. Turn right at the street, (Bundarra St.). Move to the left side, there are two houses here. Go around the second house and down the hill on the mowed grass. The camp track starts just past the house's back fence at the Telstra (Telecom) pit. The track is marked by paint markers right to the camp H.Q.
